The HOLY SPIRIT speaks to people directly through many means. He is the best source for insights, ideas, strategies, and action points.

Coaches help the coachee to hear the Holy Spirit more clearly and support them to respond well.

Am I trusting the Holy Spirit? See John 14:26

Celebrate all FORWARD movement.

Four key elements facilitate TRANSFORMATION:

- 1. Holy Spirit
- 2. Discovery
- 3. Action
- 4. Reinforcement

Each is essential to the transformational formula.

Transformation

T = (D + A + R)HS

Transformation rarely happens without all four.

The CHRISTIAN COACH plays an important role in helping coachees to think through how they are processing their spiritual discernment with others and how they might involve the appropriate members of the Body of Christ in that process.

Coachees mature through their interaction with the Body of Christ.
